Since 2008, the Jérôme Lejeune Institute has been dedicated to implementing a quality policy. This policy was reinforced in 2010 to obtain NF S96 900 certification for the BioJeL Biological Resource Center, and in August 2023 to obtain dual ISO 9001/ISO 20387 certification.

Our quality policy considers both internal and external contexts and addresses the current and future needs of researchers utilizing the BRC's collections and services. These guidelines are crafted in adherence to regulations, impartiality principles, and ethical rules governing biological resource management. BioJeL BRC is committed to:

- Providing biological resources that meet stakeholder requirements and regulations;
- Promoting the value of biological resources in national and international research;
- Enhancing the performance and efficiency of our quality management system;
- Defining and following a financial strategy to ensure the BRC's sustainability;
- Maintaining communication tools to ensure the effective dissemination of information relevant to the BRC's activities.

During our annual management reviews, we undertake to set new objectives to ensure the continuous implementation and improvement of this quality policy.

To achieve these objectives, management undertakes to providing the necessary material and technical resources and means, as well as hierarchical and functional support, while delegating the responsibility for organizing and sustaining all BioJeL BRC activities to the research director and the steering committee.

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
